

LEARNING FROM SERIOUS SAFEGUARDING PRACTICE REVIEWS (FOCUS ON NEGLECT)

THURSDAY 1 DECEMBER (12.30-2.00PM) & WEDNESDAY 11 JANUARY 2023 (12.30-2.00PM)

When a child dies or is seriously harmed, as a result of abuse or neglect, a review may be conducted to identify ways that professionals and organisations can improve the way they work together to safeguard children and prevent similar incidents from occurring.

These hour and a half briefing sessions will be delivered by colleagues from the Safeguarding Partnership Case Review Group. The event will cover the themes and learning from the latest Local Safeguarding Children Practice Reviews (LSCPRs) and other safeguarding children case reviews. It is really important that you know about these reviews, and the learning from them, so that the service improvements identified become embedded in to practice.

In particular these session will cover learning from the unpublished 'Family CC' LCSPR and three recent 'rapid reviews' which were conducted by the partnership in 2022, following serious safeguarding incidents.
